Eligibility Rules

Eligibility of Partnerships:

- ✓ The project partnership must involve at least two (2) beneficiaries, one from each Partner State.
- ✓ Shall consist of two types of beneficiaries, the Lead Beneficiary (LB) and the Project Beneficiary (PB).
- ✓ The partnership scheme must not exceed five (5) beneficiaries.
- ✓ Beneficiaries shall cooperate in the development and implementation of operations, as well as in the staffing or financing of operations, or both.
- ✓ Each beneficiary may submit up to five (5) Project Proposals in the Present Call.



Applicants outside the eligible area:

- ☑ Organisations, which are located outside the Programme area but a branch office is established in the Programme area
- ☑ Bodies of the central government located outside the Programme area (e.g. Ministries or other governmental authorities with specific competencies on national level);
- ✓ Organisations located outside the Programme area but inside the Partner States, as long as their participation in the project brings added value and expertise to its implementation and benefits the Programme cooperation area.



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Activities outside the Programme area



All activities of a project should take place within the Programme area, unless:

- ✓ the activities are for the benefit of the Programme area;
- ✓ the activities are essential for the implementation of the project;
- ✓ the implementation and/ or the relevance of the activity have been approved by the Programme bodies beforehand.
- ✓ Infrastructure located outside the Programme area, even if it is directly related to the project, is not eligible



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Eligibility of applicants

- A. National, regional, and local public bodies,
- B. Bodies governed by public law ((as defined in Article 2(4) of Directive 2014/24/EU):
- ✓ they are established for the specific purpose of meeting needs in the general interest, not having an industrial or commercial character;
- ✓ they have legal personality and
- ✓ they are financed for the most part by the State, regional or local authorities or by other bodies governed by public law;
- C. Bodies governed by private law non-profit organizations,
- ✓ they are not established to obtain profit;
- ✓ they do not distribute profits to the shareholders;
- ✓ they should have at least completed one accounting year of operation before the specific call for proposals launch. This rule is also applicable to the local-regional branch offices.
- D. International organizations registered under the national law of the Partner States of the Programme are considered eligible if they fulfill the criteria foreseen for the non-profit bodies governed by private law,
- E. European Grouping of Territorial Cooperation (EGTC) governed by the law of one of the participating countries where the EGTC has its registered office

Important note:

Potential Beneficiaries of categories B, C, E should have at least completed one accounting year of operation before the launching of the Call for proposals

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Non-eligible types of applicants

- 1. SMEs and profitable organizations
- 2. International organizations operating under international law
- 3. EGTCs located outside the Programme area and not registered in one of the Partner States participating in the cross-border Programme
- 4. Organisations located outside the Programme area not registered in one of the Partner States participating in the cross-border Programme
- 5. Bodies governed by public law, private non-profit organizations and EGTCs, newly established, not having completed at least one year of operation before the launching of the Call for proposals.
- 6. Branches of bodies governed by public law and private non-profit organizations, located in the Programme area but not having completed at least one year of operation before the launching of the Call for proposals




